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Expectations

OF THE CATECHUMEN FOR THE PASTOR AND DEACONESS

- That they will be prepared for class
- That they will pay attention to me and my concerns
- That they will answer my questions to the best of their ability, and if they don't know the answer, they will seek to have an answer by the next week
- That they will learn the catechism by heart with me
- That they will pray for me as I learn and grow in the "Faith once delivered to the saints"

OF THE PARENT FOR THE PASTOR AND DEACONESS

- That they will make every attempt to communicate with me what is expected of me and my child
- That they will be reasonable in their expectations, and will be understanding when scheduling conflicts occur
- That they will help me to understand my role as a parent, and will respect my position as the primary person God has entrusted to take care of my child

OF THE PASTOR FOR THE CATECHUMEN

- That the catechumen will be prepared for class
- That the catechumen will learn the catechism by heart
- That the catechumen will ask questions, and not sit there like a bump on a log
- That the catechumen will engage in the process of learning what it means to be a Lutheran Christian

OF THE PASTOR FOR THE PARENT

- That the parent will insure that their children attend church and Sunday School every week
- That the parent will make certain their children are prompt and faithful in their confirmation class attendance
- That the parent will be a part of learning what it means to be a Lutheran Christian
- That the parent will inform them if there are scheduling conflicts at least 3 days in advance so that they may be worked out
- That the parent will assist their children in learning the catechism by heart
